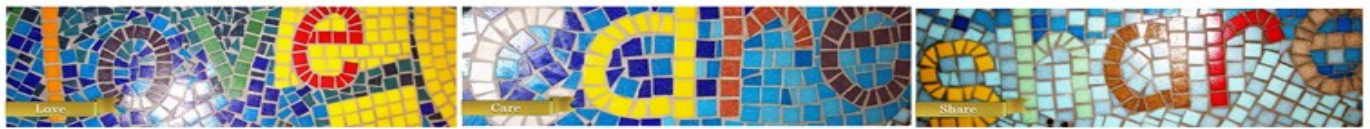

If your child usually has a packed lunch but would like to have Christmas dinner in school please contact the office for more details.

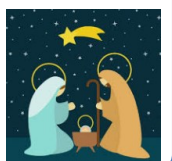
